

In collaboration with the Arkansas River Outfitters Association, we hosted this kick-off to summer rafting day on the Arkansas. Club kids came from Fremont, Pueblo, High Rockies, San Luis Valley, and Denver. Participating raft companies included: Noah's Ark, Wilderness Aware, Rocky Mt. Outdoor Center, River Runners, The Adventure Company, Arkansas River Tours, Royal Gorge Rafting, Raftmasters, and Echo Canyon River Expeditions. Rafting took place at two different spots on the river, the Milk Run in Buena Vista, and Big Horn Canyon in Fremont County. For many of our kids, and most of the kids from other Clubs, this was their first experience rafting. The weather was warm, water was high, and guides were great! Club kids ended the day by asking when we can go rafting again. We are so appreciative to all of the guides

and companies that showed us down the river, to the El Pomar Foundation for sponsoring this day, and to Wendell Pryor for envisioning this day.














Recap on Irene's Youth of the Year Journey
